## Ethics Storytelling Workshops

These are three-hour workshops, held at your organisation with a team of up to 8 people at a time. It is a facilitated storytelling process, with the aim of reflecting on (but not limited to) COVID-19 related experiences and learning more about ethics through such reflection.



## Ethics Awareness Training

Ethics awareness forms the basis for conscious practice of ethics in our organisations. Training in this regard helps to create a shared language for talking about ethics, to have tools to use in unpacking ethical tensions and dilemmas as well as ways of thinking through what action to take.



## Ethics Consultations

An ethics consultation provides a supportive and advisory space to talk through difficult ethics situations and dilemmas, and to consider options of what action to take.
